State Appointed Title Application Scoring Process

1. **Application Resume:** The application and Resume is the first step in the selection process. Your score will be based on neatness, activities and personality. You must submit your \$25 Registration Fee along with your application and resume.
2. **Application Photo:** The application photo is judged along with the application resume. Your photo will be scored on overall presentation and quality. Please be sure that you are the only person featured in your photo. Photos can be emailed or mailed and will not be returned.
3. **Telephone Interview:** The telephone interview is the third step in the selection process. Once your application has been reviewed, we will schedule a brief telephone conversation between you and the selection committee. There are no right or wrong answers. We just want to take to opportunity to get to know you.
4. **Parent Interview:** The final step of the process is the Parent Interview. Parents are major parts of preparing contestants for the national level competition. This interview is much different from the contestant's interview. Again, there are no right or wrong answers. However, we must be sure that parents understand the process and will be fully supportive of the new All American Girl State Queen. For applicants that are ages 19 years and older, the parent interview is optional and a second interview will be required should the contestant decide to act as their own chaperone instead.

The winners of the Appointed State Title Program will represent their state at the 2010 National All American Girl Pageant in Portland, Oregon. The runners-up will be awarded an opportunity to fill additional city/county/regional titles for the chance to compete at the 2010 National Finals.

As an appointed state title holder, you will have the option to be crowned at your closest state pageant along with invitations to make appearance at All American Girl pageants across the county.

The division winners of the overall Appointed State Title Program for each state will win a \$100.00 credit towards their National Finals sponsorship fee After paying their State Sponsorship fee of \$295.00.

We understand that you if you are selected you will be anxious and excited to receive your official state crown, Scepter, pin and sash. Once you have paid your state sponsorship fee of \$295.00 in full we will order and ship your state crown and sash.

Once you receive your official AAG crown, scepter, pin and sash, you will be able to use them to visit local and neighboring state pageants/events along with the opportunity to collect additional ads for a chance to win the Prestigious National Cover Girl Award.

All State Title holders are responsible for their own meals, activities, wardrobe, travel and lodging. If you are selected to represent your state, you will receive an official AAG National Finals Handbook with detailed information to help you prepare for the upcoming event.
